- **Whereas,** By bringing Jewish American Heritage Month to our cities, we offer hope and optimism through the celebration of the vibrant heritage of the Jewish Americans who have enriched our country and our communities for hundreds of years; and
- **Whereas,** As leaders of America's cities, we must create the conditions that allow our communities to be safe, healthy, and vital;
